- I. **Call to Order at 6:05pm**
 - a. Attendees: Jason, Heather, Ken, Mary, Nina, Lyn, Ady, Lya, Kathy (Carlson)
- II. **Approvals**
 - a. Approval of Agenda – added pink slip for band truck to New Business, moved & approved
 - b. Approval of Minutes – approved
- III. **Band Directors Report** – Jason shared an email from Richard: Richard has not yet had a chance to call Tim about the instrument repair, but will do so when he has a chance. Final uniform fittings will occur on Wednesdays and Fridays. Richard does not want to make changes to the band's format this year; rather, he wants to support the band/students/parents. Richard will talk with the Yuba City Color Guard coach about being a coach for our band. Richard will ask for volunteers from the band for students who are willing not to play their instrument during parade competitions and to be in color guard. Richard will be on the school site on the 6th and 7th to prep.
- IV. **Officer Reports**
 - a. President – Status quo for Sac State event for now, but we need to address the lack of uniforms for all band students. We also need to address color guard supplies. In the past, Levi ordered them, but Jason will ask Richard how he would like to proceed with this issue.
 - b. Vice President – Will get the laptop and software for Nina to use in for the uniforms.
 - c. Treasurer's Report – printed reports provided
 - d. Secretary's Report – nothing to report
- V. **Old business**
 - a. Trailer update: Jason has the keys for the trailer. He is looking at using a 6x8 cargo net to keep hats and shoes secure in the trailer during travel. Jason presented an idea to provide the Seniors a small section on the inside of the trailer to paint or write something to commemorate their last year in band. Jason will call about painting the trailer.
 - b. 2013/14 Budget – printed version provided of the modified budget. Five items were modified and the new budget was approved
 - c. Sticker Sales: Only one student turned in sticker sale money. Jason will talk with Eric about the list that was used last year with the names of the businesses that students could go to for sticker sales. We also discussed a reward system for students who submitted their sticker sales money and said that the final date to do so is 10/4 to be eligible for a reward. For those students who meet this deadline, they will receive a \$10 gift card.
 - d. Family BBQ: Lyon's Park has been reserved. Ady will purchase meat/buns for 200 people. The students will have a rehearsal at the high school from 9 to noon and the BBQ will start at 1 p.m. The board members will discuss with the parents their specific role with the band. For the football games, Lya will

setup the band area in the stands and Ken/Mary will be the room monitors when the students are dressing for the games. We need tables for the BBQ. Lya and Lyn will set up and monitor the sign-up sheets(during the BBQ) for parent volunteers for band events.

VI. New Business

- a. Committee chairs: The intention at the BBQ is to get new members to take over committee chairs for next year.
- b. Shadowing outgoing leads: We need new people to shadow the uniform and snack bar chairs for next year.
- c. Band Truck – Ady raised a question about the pink slip for the band truck and whether the pink slip is in the Band's name or not. Jason will send an email to Matt and the District office about the band getting some money for the sale of the band truck, considering the \$1000 the band recently put into the purchase of new tires for the truck.
- d. Car wash: Jason will send an email to Richard about dates for the car wash that will work for him.
- e. The 10% Back from Safeway will be in effect from 8/14-9/10.

VII. Committee Reports

- a. Uniforms (Nina) – Nina is concerned that the lack of uniform issue will not be resolved before Sac State on 9/21. The board decided that if the uniforms are not ready for this event, the band will not go as we do not want the students to be dressed in just their camp shirts because all the other bands will be in uniform. Nina needs more help from parents during competitions and the board discussed including specific tasks that parents can sign up for such as: hair, shoes, plumes, water for the students, etc.

- c. Drumline/Winter Guard – Mr. Sabato will be coaching this year.
- d. Chaperone – Lya can chaperone and will need a list of the parents' email who signed up to chaperone the competitions.
