- B. Family BBQ – Jason will bring tables, BBQ, ice chests and ice. Lya will work the volunteer sign-up table. Kellie will make sign-up sheets for the various jobs available throughout the year. Nina will send Kellie job list for the football games.
- C. Band Truck – cannot sell the truck until Jan 2014, but Mr. Barnes said we will get the money for it. We will need to check on this again in the New Year.
- D. Band Trailer – registered under CBA name with DMV. It is officially ours; need to fix the wiring harness to legally tow it.

## **VI. New Business**

- A. Planning for first football game (9/6/13) – in 2 ½ weeks. Field show will not be a moving show. Snack bar prep will be done by Aug 24<sup>th</sup>. Our prices will stay the same; Richard will relay this to Joe Volek, the Athletic Director. Need to confirm that Bryan B will continue as pit crew and Jason will try to find a freshman dad to shadow Bryan this year for future years. Will need sign-up sheets for all the jobs are the 4 football games and the 2 powder puff games (Oct 11 and Oct 30)
- B. Safeway 10% goes back to school program – Receipt collection is Sept 13-26. Lynn needs coffee cans to leave at registers for collecting receipts. Will solicit volunteers at BBQ to help with this.
- C. Car wash (8/31/13) – Need buckets, sponges, towels. Eric should have all the donated towels from last year. Need sign-ups for adults and students for this event as well.
- D. Script needs – Lynn Akin is doing it and needs to pass it on to someone else.
- E. September CBA meeting date conflict – Moving to first Monday of each month, except September's will be on the 9<sup>th</sup> due to the holiday. Time will stay at 5:30pm.
